

Information regarding your next appointment with the orthodontist

1.



You will be telephoned beforehand to explain what to expect at the practice and to ask about symptoms (including fever, new/continuous/persistent cough, loss of taste/smell) and shielding.

You can let us know beforehand if you wish to purchase oral hygiene items.

2.



Brush your teeth and gums thoroughly before coming to the surgery

You will be asked to wait outside until orthodontist is ready to see you. Please be prepared for bad weather.

Do not bring any unnecessary items with you, but remember to bring your own face covering.

For your own and our safety only patient to enter the surgery

3.



You will have your temperature checked on arrival.

You will be asked to gel your hands.

You may be asked to rinse with a mouthwash before your treatment commences.

Your orthodontist may be wearing Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) before you enter the room so please don't be alarmed.
